Work Session Recommendations

SB 235 with the -B10 amendment amends the Oregon Indoor Clean Air Act by allowing use of tobacco products in an enclosed area that is outdoors. The -B10 amendment restores the bill to what the Senate originally passed, and removes all new licensing and regulatory requirements that are included in the $B$-Engrossed version.

The measure and the original staff measure summaries are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). A fiscal impact statement related to the -B10 amendment, as well as a preliminary staff measure summary is posted in Meeting Materials.

The measure previously had hearings in the Senate Committee on Health Care on 2/7/17, $2 / 9 / 17$ and $4 / 18 / 17$. It had hearings in the House Committee on Health Care on 5/15/17 and 5/22/17.

The fiscal impact is minimal.
