

HB 3361

Relating to open data standards

HB 3361 establishes the position of Chief Data Officer, appointed by the State Chief Information Officer, to develop and maintain a web portal for state agencies to release all publishable data. The Officer will establish an open data standard, publish a technical standards manual, create an inventory of publicly available state data and suggest analytical opportunities for state agencies.

The Office of the Chief Information Officer will leverage the existing transparency website infrastructure to comply with the bill. Funding for this bill includes money for the Chief Data Officer, as well as moneys to add capacity to the state's open data portal.

The General Government Subcommittee recommends HB 3361 be amended by the –A18 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
