## SB 1062 Relating to environmental conditions in school facilities

SB 1062 establishes the Healthy School Facilities Fund and carves-out (beginning on or after July 1, 2019) \$2 million of State School Funds from the existing facilities grant allocation to test and reduce exposure to elevated levels of lead in water, lead-based paint, and installing carbon monoxide detectors.

The bill has a \$111,577 General Fund impact to the Department of Education for 1 position (0.50 FTE) in the 2017-19 biennium.

The Education Subcommittee recommends SB 1062 be amended by the –A3 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
