

SB 235

Relating to public health

SB 235, with the –B10 amendment, amends the Oregon Indoor Clean Air Act by allowing use of tobacco products in an enclosed area that is outdoors. The amendment restores the bill to what the Senate originally passed, and removes all new licensing and regulatory requirements that are included in the B-Engrossed version.

The fiscal impact is minimal.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends SB 235 be amended by the –B10 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
