HB 3203

Relating to analysis required before a contracting agency constructs a public improvement with the agency's own equipment and personnel

HB 3203 requires contracting agencies to prepare and file with the Bureau of Labor and Industries information on planned public improvements.

It specifies that if a contracting agency intends to perform work on a public improvement with a cost over \$200,000 using the agency's own equipment or personnel, the agency must complete an analysis demonstrating that the decision conforms to state policy.

HB 3203 also requires BOLI to conduct a review every four years to determine several items, including whether the methodology used by contracting agencies to calculate costs and threshold amounts should be adjusted.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends HB 3203 be amended by the –B14 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
