

SB 693

Relating to driving privileges

SB 693 eliminates probationary driving permits, standardizes requirements for hardship permits, and eliminates driving privilege suspensions for certain criminal offenses.

The Joint Committee on Ways and Means previously approved this bill, and it has passed the Senate.

The –B5 amendment resolves conflicts with SB 754.

I recommend SB 693 be amended by the –B5 conflict amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
