

HB 2191

Relating to business entities

HB 2191 authorizes the Secretary of State to investigate alleged or potential violations of business registration statutes, and to require business entities to provide a list of shareholders and respond to questions relating to potential violations of business registration law.

The Joint Committee on Ways and Means previously approved this bill, and it has passed the House.

The –B11 amendment resolves conflicts with HB 2610. That bill, which has been enacted into law, updated the process for electronic transmission and signature of corporate notices and documents. In that process, HB 2610 amended two ORS sections that HB 2191 also amends. The conflict amendments insert the new HB 2610 language into HB 2191.

I recommend HB 2191 be amended by the –B11 conflict amendments and be reported out do pass, as amended.
