## SUMMARY

Directs Administrator of the Division of Child Support of the Department of Justice to conduct statewide study regarding child support no later than July 1, 2018.

Requires administrator to submit report regarding study to interim legislative committees no later than November 1, 2018.

Sunsets January 1, 2019.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to child support; and declaring an emergency.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) No later than July 1, 2018, the Administrator of the 5 Division of Child Support of the Department of Justice shall conduct 6 a statewide study regarding the establishment, modification and 7 enforcement of child support orders in this state. The administrator 8 shall collaborate with the office of the Attorney General and district 9 attorney offices in conducting the study under this subsection.

10 (2) No later than November 1, 2018, the administrator shall submit 11 a report to the interim legislative committees related to child welfare 12 and domestic relations regarding the study conducted in accordance 13 with subsection (1) of this section.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 1, 2019.
<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate pres ervation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is de clared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.
