SUMMARY

Reduces penalties for crime of possession of gambling records in the second degree. Punishes by maximum of six months' imprisonment, \$2,500 fine, or both.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to crime; amending ORS 167.132.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 167.132 is amended to read:

5 167.132. (1) A person commits the crime of possession of gambling records

6 in the second degree if, with knowledge of the contents thereof, the person7 possesses any writing, paper, instrument or article:

8 (a) Of a kind commonly used in the operation or promotion of a
9 bookmaking scheme or enterprise; or

10 (b) Of a kind commonly used in the operation, promotion or playing of a 11 lottery or numbers scheme or enterprise.

(2) Possession of gambling records in the second degree is a Class [A] B
misdemeanor.
