## SUMMARY

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to conduct study on long-term consequences of criminal convictions and present report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2018.

Sunsets January 2, 2019.

Relating to convictions.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall conduct a study on the long-term consequences of criminal convictions, including housing and employment opportunities, and present the results of the study, along with any recommended legislative changes, in a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before September 15, 2018.**

**SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2019.**
