WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Measure clarifies duties and language relating to the standards for the delegation of patient care tasks. Measure expands the types of stakeholders the Board may engage when amending Oregon law that governs the administration of non-injectable medication by nursing assistants (ORS 678.150(6)(i)).
