WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Adds exemption for balance trailers transporting a dory to list of vehicles exempt from brake requirements.

BACKGROUND:

Fisherman have been launching dories from the beach at Cape Kiwanda since the early 1900s. Pacific dory's are flat bottomed fishing boats designed to be launched and retrieved from the beach. The dory's are launched and retrieved from the beach via a trailer and tow vehicle, typically a four wheel drive vehicle. Other vehicles exempted from the brake requirements include; farm tractors, road machinery, and electric personal assistive mobility devices.
