## **SUMMARY**

Requires Oregon Health Authority to conduct study of effectiveness of Oregon Integrated and Coordinated Health Care Delivery System in improving health outcomes for medical assistance recipients.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall conduct a study
- 5 to evaluate the effectiveness of the Oregon Integrated and Coordinated
- 6 Health Care Delivery System in improving the health outcomes expe-
- 7 rienced by medical assistance recipients. The study must take into
- 8 account the outcome and quality measures reported by coordinated
- 9 care organizations in accordance with ORS 414.625 (2)(L), client sur-
- 10 veys and other information available to the authority.
- 11 (2) No later than September 15, 2018, the authority shall report to
- 12 the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health,
- in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, the results of the study de-
- scribed in subsection (1) of this section and recommendations, if any,
- 15 for legislative changes to the Oregon Integrated and Coordinated
- 16 Health Care Delivery System that are necessary to improve the health
- outcomes of medical assistance recipients in this state.
- 18 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2019.

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
