SUMMARY

Clarifies law regarding health insurance coverage required for orally administered anticancer drugs.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2 Relating to health insurance; amending ORS 743A.068; and declaring an

3 emergency.

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4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 743A.068 is amended to read:

743A.068. (1) A health benefit plan that provides coverage for 6 intravenously administered or injected cancer medications or coverage 7 for prescription drugs for the treatment of cancer [chemotherapy treat-8 *ment*] must provide coverage for a prescribed, orally administered anticancer 9 medication used to kill or slow the growth of cancerous cells on a basis no 10 less favorable than [intravenously administered or injected cancer medications 11 that are covered as medical benefits] the other covered benefits. 1213 (2) As used in this section, "health benefit plan" has the meaning given that term in ORS 743B.005. 14

15 (3) The provisions of ORS 743A.001 do not apply to this section.

SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.

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
