
Safety and Health of Students

Lack of sidewalks Lack of street lights Cars in the area speed, ignore traffic laws Dark, foggy in the morning


<u>Risks</u>

Comparison

W. L. Henry Elementary School (no busing) & Eastwood Elementary School (busing)

Similarities

High ELL percentages (76%, 50%) A large population of mobile students (15%, 13.4%) Both qualify for federal mandated 100% free lunch

Differences

W.L. Henry's median class size is 4 children smaller (23, 27)
W.L. Henry's Regular Attenders are almost 5% lower
W. L. Henry has ~150 LESS students than Eastwood, we had 8 MORE chronically absent students

Student Achievement

Attendance

The Chronic Absenteeism Report identified transportation as a potential barrier to attendance. That rings true at W. L. Henry.

Tardiness

We have observed that students come in later when it's rainy, cold, and/or icy.

Focus

Teachers tell me that it takes longer to get the class in order when it rains. Students come in wet and cold, they are warming up and it affects their focus. Thank you.
