WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Revises statutes to maintain accuracy. Corrects punctuation and grammatical errors. Conforms language to legislative style. Removes obsolete references, standardizes terminology, and removes statutes from inappropriate series. Updates references to merged state agencies. Corrects citation to federal law. Clarifies impact of organizational meetings on member appointment to committees. Makes others nonsubstantive corrections.
