Governor Brown's Vision: Every Oregon student graduates with a plan for their future.

Purpose

- 1. The High School Graduation and College and Career Readiness Act, aligns to Governor Brown's vision. In her recommended budget, the Governor prioritized her graduation vision through more focused efforts in our schools and communities to identify and engage students at-risk of not graduating high school and supporting the success of these students through effective, culturally responsive practices, interventions and trauma informed approaches. <u>By designating \$141 million in new CTE formula funding to K-12 schools, Governor Brown also signaled her support for the High School</u> <u>Graduation and College and Career Readiness Act</u>.
- 2. Ensure that implementation of the *High School Graduation and College and Career Readiness Act* results in improved graduation outcomes. Seek input from key stakeholders to discuss ideas, hopes or suggestions regarding policy development and implementation of the Measure.
