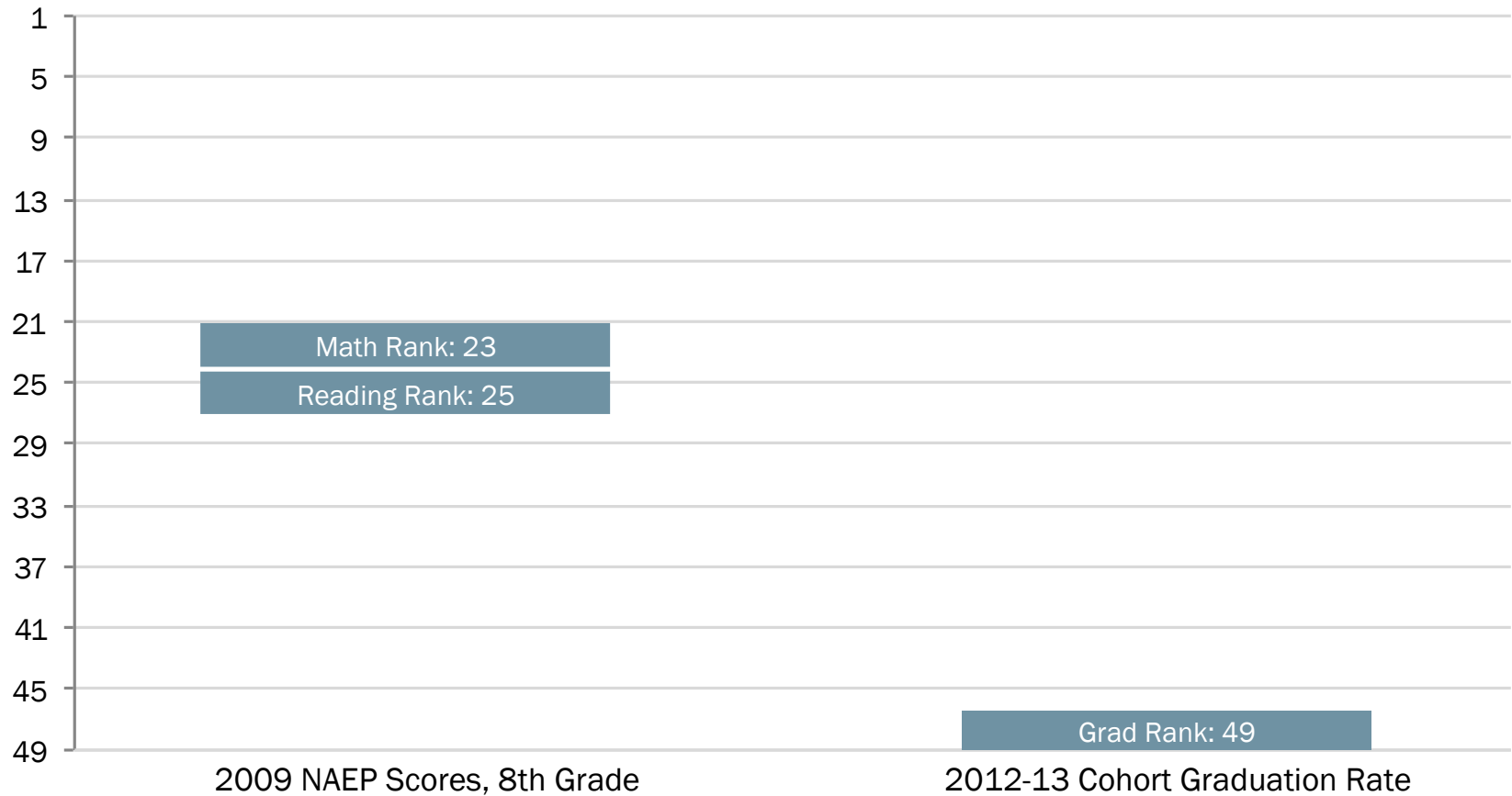


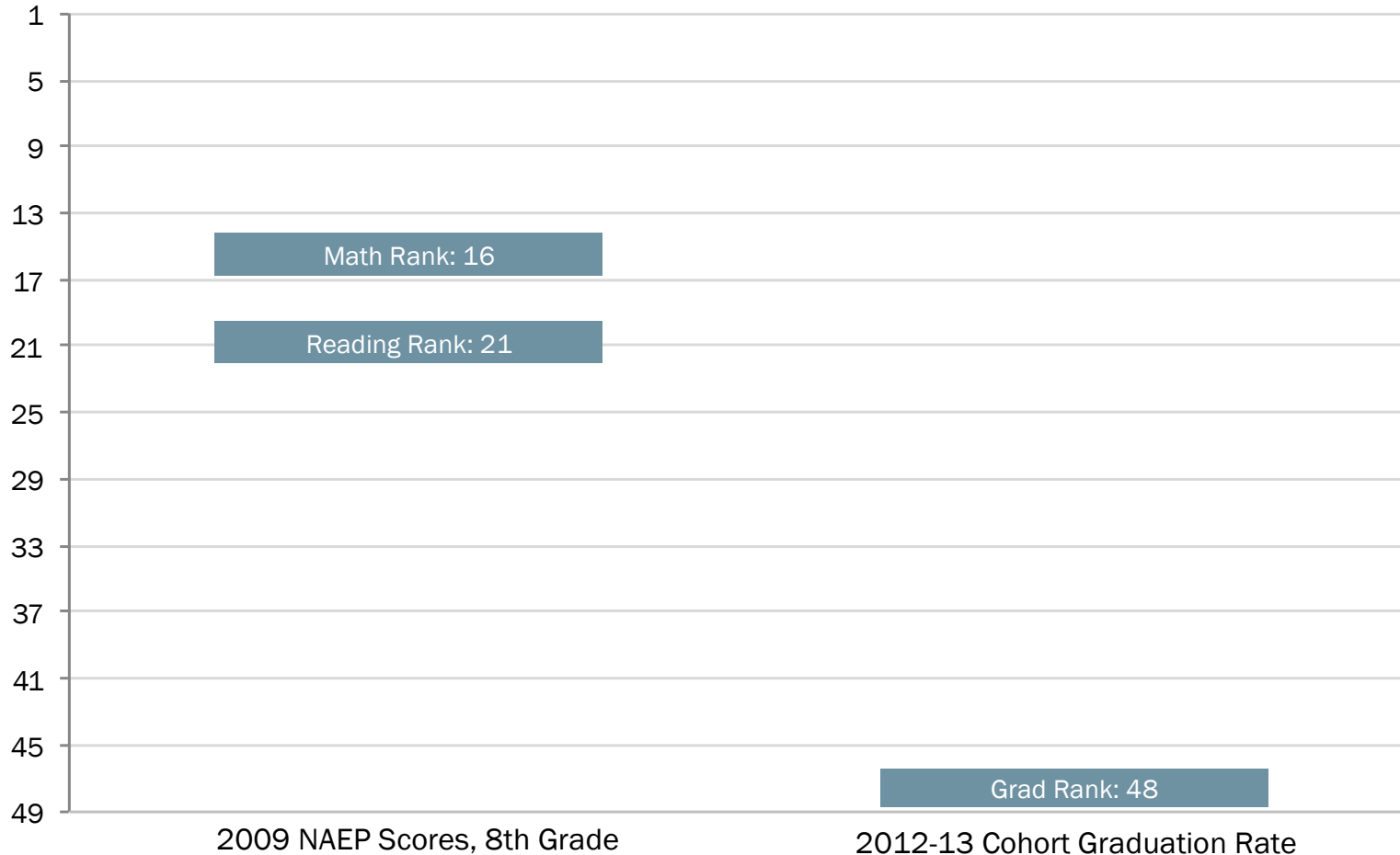

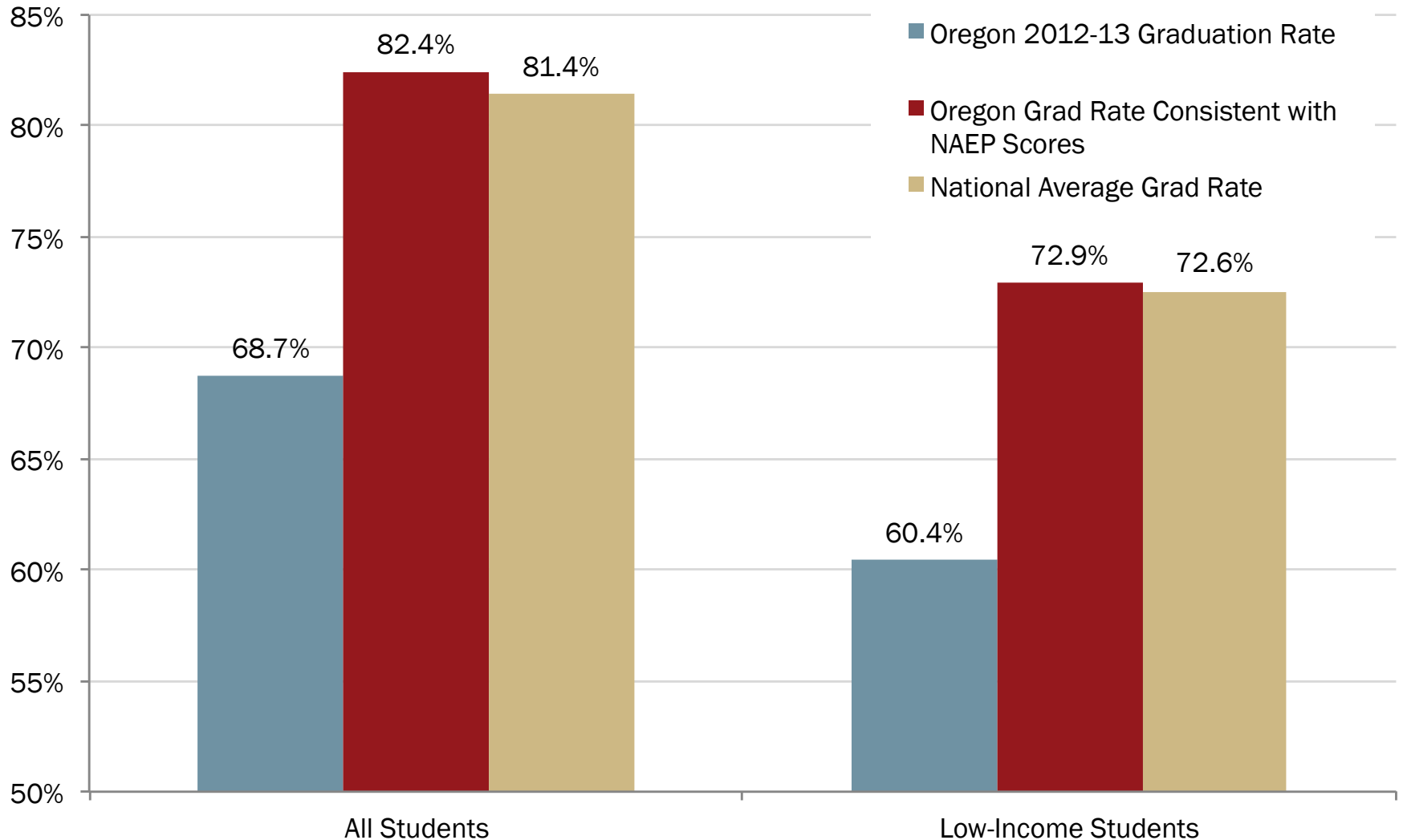

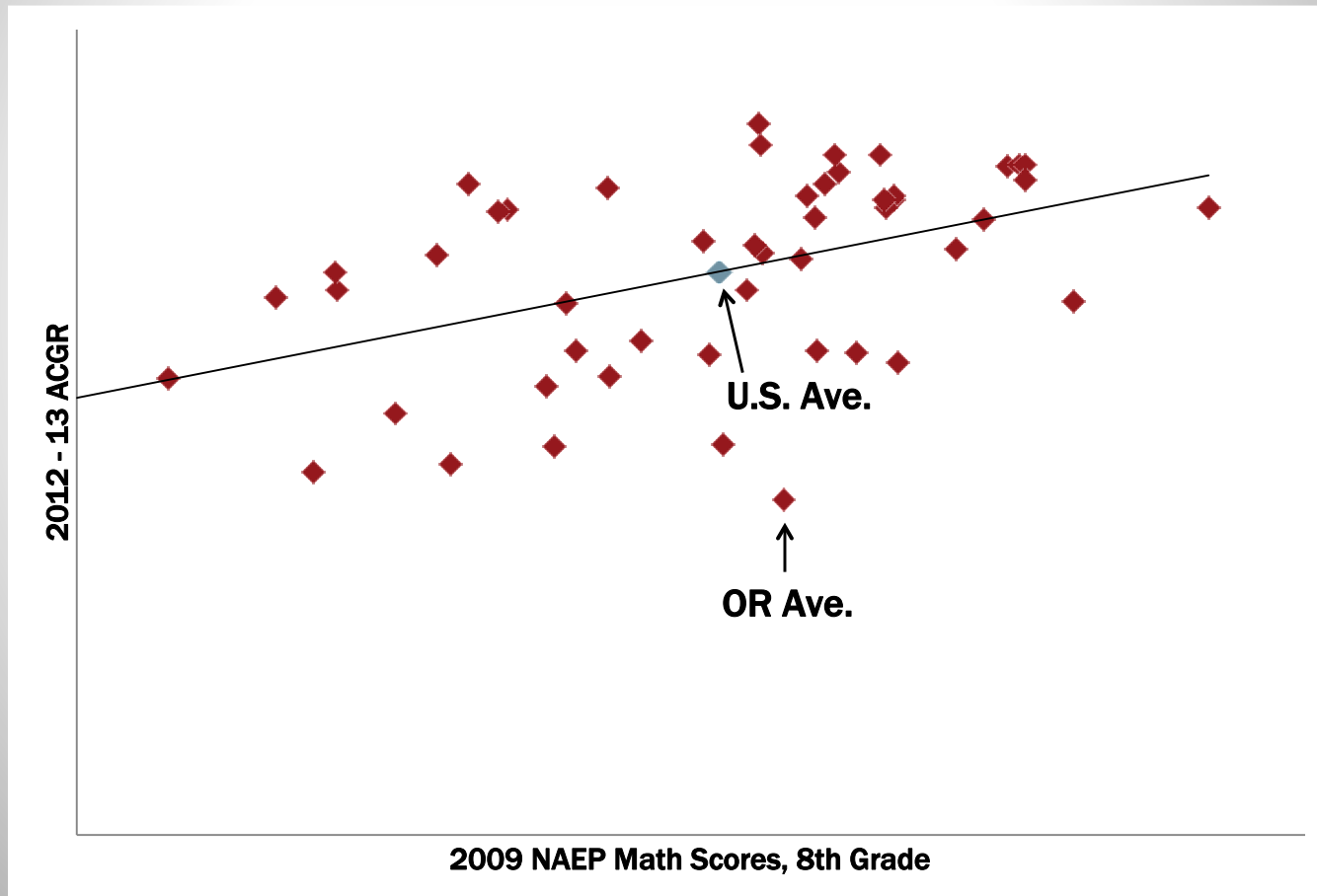


## Cohort Graduation Rate and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade NAEP Reading Scores<sup>1</sup>



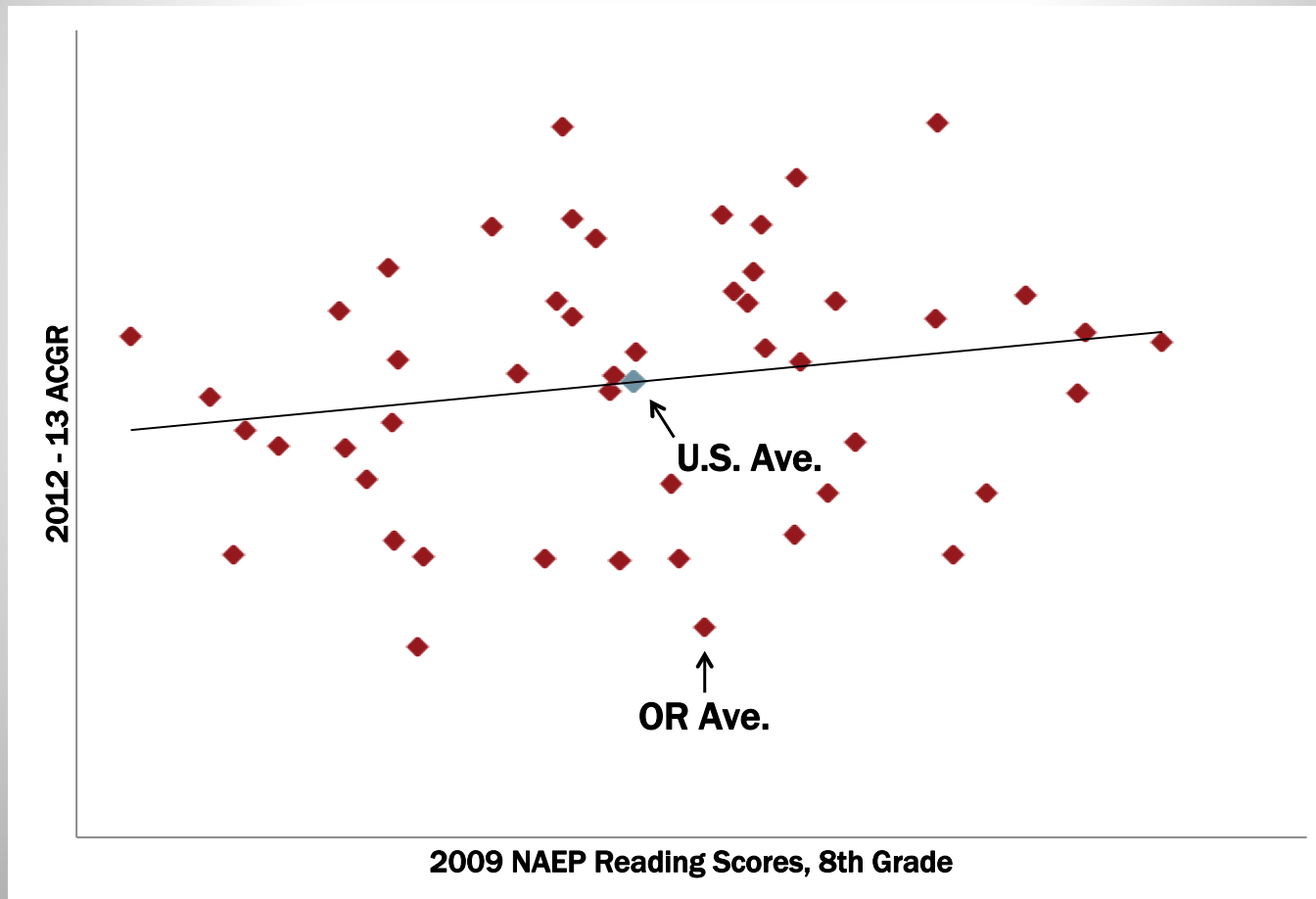

## Cohort Graduation Rate and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade NAEP Math Scores<sup>1</sup>



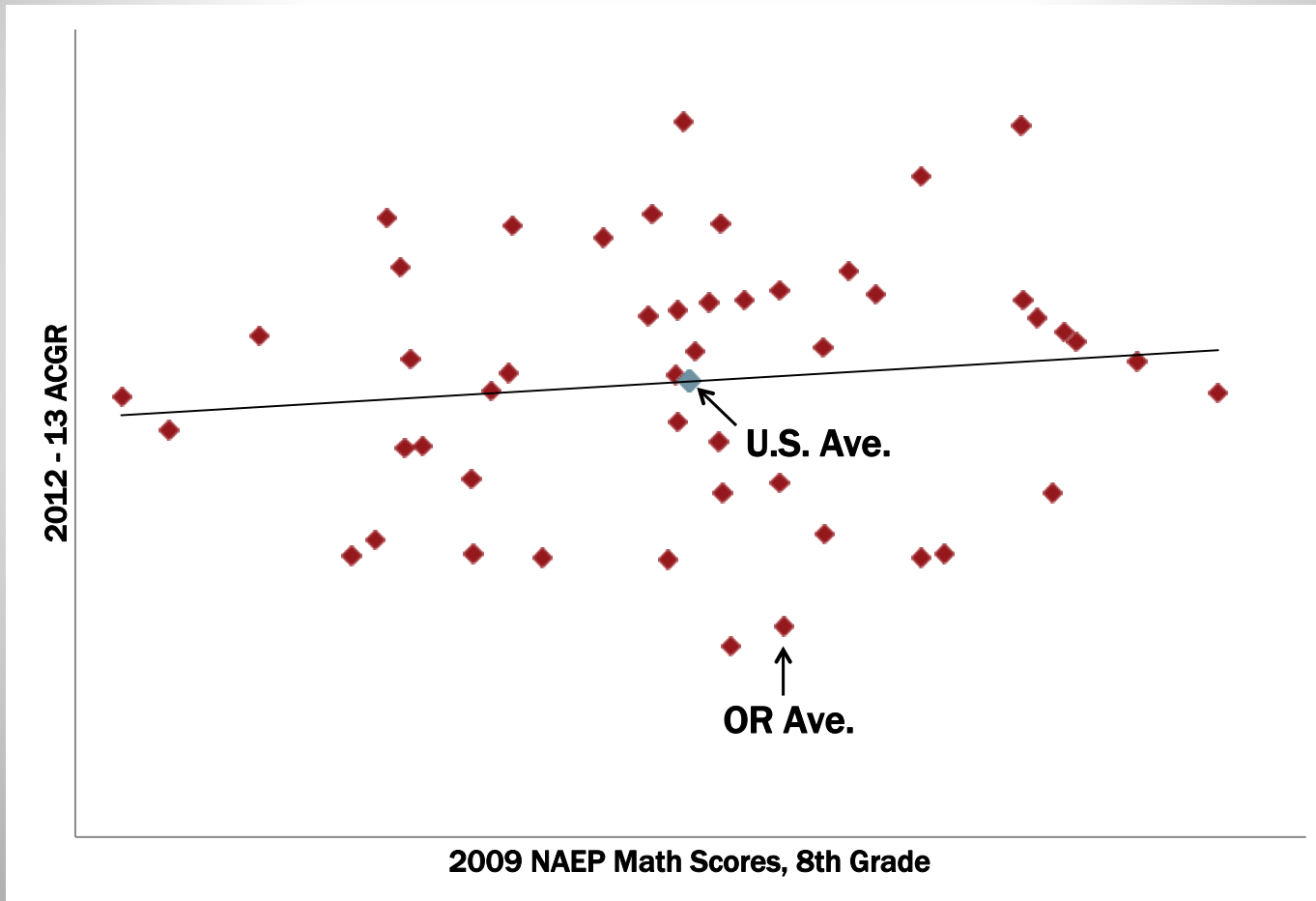
