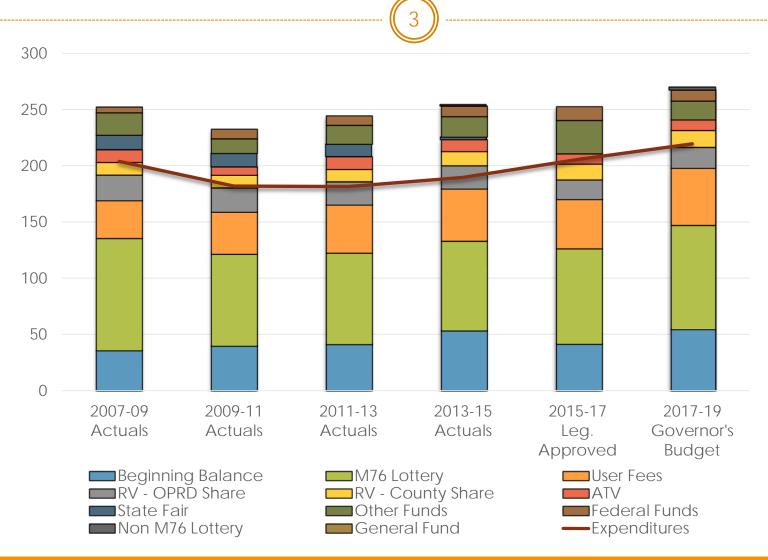

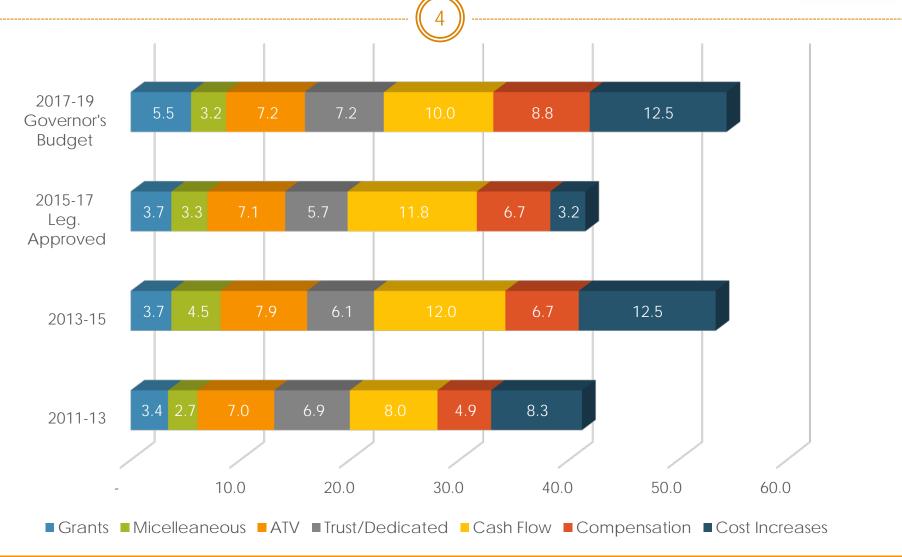
Revenue and Expenditure History





Beginning Balance History - Lottery + Other



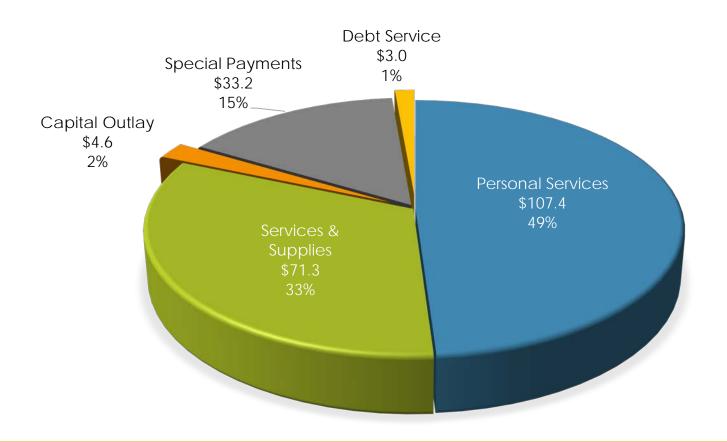

AGENCY BUDGET BY EXPENDITURE CATEGORY (IN MILLIONS)

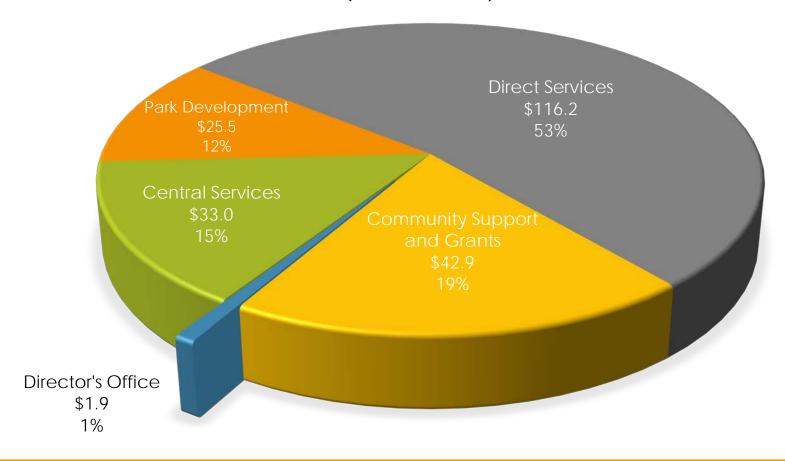
