Creates Class A violation for littering without culpable mental state.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued

### **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

#### **BACKGROUND:**

ORS 164.805 describes the Class C misdemeanor of Offensive Littering. This crime is committed when a person intentionally permits trash to be thrown from a vehicle the person is operating, or when a person intentionally discards trash or sewage on a public way or on private property without the consent of the property owner. Offensive Littering is punishable by a maximum of 30 days' imprisonment, a \$1,250 fine, or both.
