WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires the Department of Education (ODE) to provide technical assistance and support to school districts and community colleges for prevention of and response to interpersonal violence, including sexual assault. Establishes program requirements.

BACKGROUND:

The National Center for Education Statistics reports that in 2013, approximately three percent of students 12-18 years old reported being victimized at school. The Center's data are based on sample surveys, so Oregon-specific information is not available.
