## **SUMMARY**

Clarifies educational requirements for registration of behavior analysis interventionists.

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- 2 Relating to applied behavior analysis; creating new provisions; and amending
- 3 ORS 676.815.

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- 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 676.815 is amended to read:
- 6 676.815. The Health Licensing Office shall establish by rule criteria for
- 7 the registration of behavior analysis interventionists. The criteria must in-
- 8 clude, but are not limited to, the requirement that the applicant:
- 9 (1) Have a high school diploma[ or], a General Educational Development
- 10 (GED) certificate or a degree from a post-secondary institution;
  - (2) Be at least 18 years of age;
- 12 (3) Have successfully completed a state and nationwide criminal records 13 check that requires fingerprinting;
- 14 (4) Have completed at least 40 hours of professional training in applied 15 behavior analysis approved by the office by rule; and
- 16 (5) Receive ongoing training and supervision by a licensed behavior ana-17 lyst, by a licensed assistant behavior analyst or by another licensed health 18 care professional.
- SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 676.815 by section 1 of this 20 2017 Act apply to applications for registration as a behavior analysis 21 interventionist received by the Health Licensing Office on or after the

effective date of this 2017 Act.

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
