Timeline for public engagement that fosters active participation



## April 2016

### EQC MEETING ON TEMPORARY RULE

EQC meets to consider a temporary rule for art glass manufacturers, receive briefings on the permanent air toxic rule timeline and Washington's and California's programs for regulating air toxics from industrial facilities. Hear a presentation about current air quality regulation in Oregon and hear comments from citizens and stakeholders.

## June 2016

### HUMAN HEALTH RISK BASED RULES WEBINAR

DEQ brings experts to present Washington's and California's approaches to human health risk based rules followed by an opportunity for the public to ask questions and provide feedback to help inform the rulemaking.

## September 2016–October 2016 POLICY FORUMS

At these forums to be held at four locations around the state, DEQ and OHA present policy topics followed by an opportunity for the public to provide comment to inform the Advisory Committee discussions.

## Summer - Fall 2017 PUBLIC NOTICE & COMMENT PERIOD

Opportunity for public to comment on the draft rules available online July 15.

Fall - Winter 2017 DEQ and OHA review, respond and publish comments on the web. The agencies may also revise rules based on public comment.

## May 2016

### AIR TOXICS REGULATION WEBINAR

Through an interactive webinar the public has the opportunity to learn about air toxic regulation in Oregon and the rulemaking process and ask questions and get answers from DEQ, the Oregon Health Authority and EPA about current rules and regulations.

## June, July, 2016

### TECHNICAL WORKGROUP

This group of experts tackles the technical aspects of the rulemaking such as risk assessment and pollutant concentrations and provides an opportunity for the public to learn what informs and determines limits to guide the new rules.

## October 2016–June 2017 ADVISORY COMMITTEE

This DEQ-appointed committee makes recommendations on the rules based on public comment and the work of the Technical Workgroup and Public Policy Forums. These are public meetings with an open forum for public feedback.

## June 2017

### ADVISORY COMMITTEE FISCAL REVIEW

The Advisory Committee makes recommendations about the fee structure for the new rules and reviews the fiscal impact statement.

Early 2018 COMMISSION CONSIDERS PROPOSED RULE
