**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Requires information about energy tax incentives, tourism, local government, affordable housing incentives and environmental cleanup incentives, be added to the transparency website maintained by the State Chief Information Officer. Declares emergency, effective on passage. Becomes operative January 1, 2018.

**BACKGROUND:**

The State Chief Information Officer maintains a transparency website where a variety of records and information about state entities is publicly available, including reports, financial information, descriptions of agency functions and programs, notices of public meetings, links to administrative rules, information about contracts and economic development programs, and links and instructions how to request public records.

Senate Bill 191 adds information about energy tax incentives, tourism, local government, affordable housing incentives and environmental cleanup incentives to the Oregon transparency website.
