Dear Co-Chair Winters, Co-Chair Stark, and Members of the Subcommittee:

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on House Bill 5005 – the Criminal Justice Commission’s agency budget bill. Thank you for the commission’s leadership in helping public safety in our rural communities. These funds are crucial for our community to invest in effective strategies.

We have used \$384,139 in justice reinvestment dollars to support transitional housing needs for high-risk male and female offenders, treatment programs internally and within the community, and victim services programs.

For us to continue these enhanced programs, we are advocating for funding at a level for this program as well as protected cuts to community corrections grant-in-aid baseline funding through the Department of Corrections.

Justice Reinvestment has helped our local public safety coordinating council (LPSCC) collaborate more on these issues, finding effective and efficient ways to manage offenders at the local level. Through a grant with the Criminal Justice Commission, we have also been able to receive staff support for our LPSCC. This allows us to continue moving our progress to the next level. We ask for more time and adequate justice reinvestment funding to keep doing this work.
