WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Permits students of dentistry and dental hygiene to perform under indirect supervision of faculty in specific community-based or clinical settings. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

REVENUE:May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued.FISCAL:May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The American Dental Association's Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) is the accrediting agency for dental education programs in the United States. CODA's accreditation standards for dental hygiene programs and pre-doctoral programs do not prescribe student to faculty ratios for dentistry programs. The ratio of students to supervising faculty depends on procedure, skill level, patient condition, complexity and other factors.

Senate Bill 561 permits Oregon accredited dental education programs to allow indirect supervision of students by faculty members.
