

Expenditure History + 2017-19 Governor's Budget





#### Cost Saving Measures

- Close the 50-bed North Coast facility
- Makes adjustments to bring budgeted residential beds inline with actual usage
- Reduces county diversion and juvenile crime prevention funding
- Statewide Adjustments
  - Adjusts the DAS Price List and State Government Service Charges
  - Adjusts Attorney General rates
