I called DEQ Jim Billings for 700 NPDES suction dredge permit sales history. Here are the permit totals sales for years listed..

Department of State Land for 2016 approved 5 General authorizations or individual permits.

2012 DEQ issued 1941 NPDES permits.

2013 DEQ issued <u>1843 NPDES</u> permits. SB838 and \$150.00 Sur Charge greatly reduced permit sales up to 2014.

2014 DEQ issued 536NPDES permits.

2015 DEQ issued 251 NPDES permits

2016 DEQ issued <u>156 NPDES</u> permits. Of that total 77 permits are for 5 year permits. That means 79 permits were only for one year permits

2016 Department of State Lands approved 5 <u>General</u> authorizations or individual permits for non ESH stream listed segments. There are some ESH streams that have non ESH. <u>Miles listed.</u>

So where is the big gold rush for non ESH <u>upper reach streams</u> requiring SB-3 that might, may or could influence ESH streams?
