Directs Oregon Medical Board to issue provisional license to practice medicine in rural or medically underserved area and under supervision of licensed physician.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part

6 of ORS chapter 677.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Oregon Medical Board shall issue a provisional
license to practice medicine to an applicant who:

9 (a) Holds a degree of Doctor of Medicine from an approved school
10 of medicine;

11 (b) Passes the United States Medical Licensing Examination;

12 (c) Pays a licensure fee; and

13 (d) Meets other requirements established by the board by rule.

(2) A person who is issued a provisional license under this section
 may practice medicine:

(a) Under the supervision of a person licensed under ORS 677.100,
 677.120 or 677.133; and

(b) In a rural or medically underserved community, as defined in
 ORS 676.870.

20 (3) The board may adopt rules to carry out this section, including:

1 (a) The fee for a provisional license issued under this section; and

(b) A process to ensure the supervision required under this section.
<u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) Section 2 of this 2017 Act becomes operative on
January 1, 2018.

5 (2) The Oregon Medical Board may take any action before the op-6 erative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary 7 to enable the board to exercise, on or after the operative date specified 8 in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers 9 conferred on the board by section 2 of this 2017 Act.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date
 on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative
 Assembly adjourns sine die.
