SUMMARY

Renames crime of giving false information to a peace officer for issuance or service of a citation or for an arrest on a warrant to giving false information to a peace officer in connection with a citation or warrant. Expands crime to include person providing false information to peace officer when there is outstanding warrant for person's arrest. Punishes by maximum of one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.

 - [(b) The officer's arresting the person on a warrant.]

- 15 (2) [A person who violates this section commits] Giving false information
- 16 to a peace officer in connection with a citation or warrant is a Class
- 17 A misdemeanor.
