SUMMARY

Renames crime of giving false information to a peace officer for issuance or service of a citation or for an arrest on a warrant to giving false information to a peace officer in connection with a citation or warrant. Expands crime to include person providing false information to peace officer when there is outstanding warrant for person's arrest. Punishes by maximum of one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to giving false information to a peace officer; amending ORS 162.385.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 162.385 is amended to read:

162.385. (1) A person commits the crime of giving false information to a peace officer [*for issuance or service of a citation or for an arrest on a warrant*] **in connection with a citation or warrant** if the person knowingly uses or gives a false or fictitious name, address or date of birth to any peace officer [*for the purpose of*] **when:**

(a) The [*officer's*] **peace officer is** issuing or serving the person a citation under authority of ORS 133.055 to 133.076 or ORS chapter 153; or

[*(b) The officer's arresting the person on a warrant.*]

(b) There is an outstanding warrant for the person's arrest.

(2) [*A person who violates this section commits*] **Giving false information to a peace officer in connection with a citation or warrant is a Class A misdemeanor.**
