Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study and develop recommendations on best methods for creating common course numbers for courses within Oregon transfer module and for ensuring courses within module are commonly accepted as general education requirements at post-secondary institutions.

Requires commission to submit report detailing recommendations by October 1, 2018.

Sunsets January 2, 2019.

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission 6 shall conduct a study and develop recommendations, including rec-7 ommendations for additional legislation, on the best methods for:

8 (a) Creating common course numbers for courses within the Oregon
9 transfer module; and

10 (b) Ensuring that courses within the module are commonly ac-11 cepted as general education requirements at public post-secondary in-12 stitutions of education.

(2) The commission shall submit, in the manner provided in ORS
192.245, a report detailing the recommendations made under subsection
(1) of this section, to the interim legislative committees on higher education no later than October 1, 2018.
