WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Expands the circumstances under which the Department of Transportation may enter into an agreement with an integrator.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

An "integrator" means an entity who enters into a contract with the Department of Transportation to provide information and transact business for the Department. For example, an integrator may facilitate and complete titling and license plate transactions for a car dealership. Currently, integrators are limited to the electronic issuance of vehicle titles, immediate issuance of title and registration, and written and skills testing for driver licenses and permits, including commercial driver licenses. Additional activities could include processing junk and salvage titles, out-of-state dealer transactions, and registration renewals.
