Establishes the Task Force on Airport Subsidies. Sunsets the Task Force on December 31, 2019. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

BACKGROUND:

Senate Bill 189 creates a seven-member task force to conduct a study on potential benefits to the state of subsidizing public and private airports. Members include one senator, one state representative, representatives of private and public airports, private citizens, and the Director of the Oregon Department of Aviation or their designee. Staffing for the Task Force is provided by the Legislative Fiscal Office. The Task Force would report recommendations, including potential legislation, to the Legislative Assembly before sunsetting in December 2019.
