Prohibits employer of public safety officers from comparing citation numbers issued by public safety officers for purpose of discipline, investigation or job performance.

BACKGROUND:

Oregon law regulates how employers of public safety officers conduct investigations concerning public safety officers. These regulations include safeguards for interviews of public safety officers and timelines for completion of an investigation. Senate Bill 642 adds a requirement that employers of public safety officers may not compare citation numbers issued by public safety officers for the purpose of investigation, discipline or job performance.
