EPAs current National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) for lead is 0.15 micrograms per cubic meter.

- 4 Cosmetics & folk medicine
- 5 Tableware (ceramics & lead crystal)
- 6 Contaminated soil (roadways, lead smelters & industry)
- 7 Water from lead plumbing
- 8 Imported sources (toys, cars, metal containers, etc.)
