HB 2030 A, Removes certain restriction on number of nonresident annual black bear tags that may be issued by State Fish and Wildlife Commission for general hunting season.

Recent studies have shown that black bear populations in the state of Oregon are stable or growing. This bill will allow for better management of the black bear population. It will also streamline bear hunting regulations by allowing the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to eliminate the 4 general season fall black bear hunting zones, which were implemented to limit nonresidents.

The Oregon Legislative Sportsmen's Caucus has taken a **SUPPORT** stance on this bill and ask you to vote **AYE**.
