ONA Urges Your Support of HB Bill 2122 B

As nurses, ONA members recognize that investing in upstream public health and social determinates of health solutions is vital to improve population health. HB 2122 B is an important next step for Oregon's health systems transformation efforts. HB 2122 B

- Requires CCOs to reinvest a reasonable portion of profit margin back into local communities, increase transparency and accountability, improve access to integrated care, and safeguarding tax dollars
- Increases accountability and access to information to allow for public oversight of public funds
- Emphasizes alternative payment methodologies, moving away from fee-for-service model and toward paying health outcomes.
- Transitioning all CCOs into community-based nonprofit organizations or benefit corporations, to ensure each CCOs mission aligns with the needs of the communities they serve.

HB 2122 B will increase CCO accountability and transparency and strengthen tools to improve health outcomes through innovative models.

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
