Measure Description:

Revises continuing education requirement for residential contractors.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Construction Contractors Board (CCB)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Business and Transportation to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill revises the continuing education requirements for residential construction contractors licensed by the Construction Contractors Board (CCB) and only permits the CCB to charge fees for the continuing education program if revenues from license and renewal fees are not sufficient to cover the costs for these courses. The associated fees are assumed to be \$0.00 and would be set by rule; any future changes to the fee amount would require subsequent approval by the legislature in accordance with ORS 291.055. The elimination of these fees will result in a revenue reduction for the CCB, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
