Measure Description:

Increases number of circuit court judges in certain judicial districts.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Judicial Department

Analysis:

The measure increases by one, the number of circuit court judges for Deschutes, Jackson, Josephine, Marion, Multnomah, Douglas, and Clackamas counties and by two in Washington county. The measure includes a blank General Fund appropriation for the Judicial Department for salaries and benefits for the new judgeships and support staff.

This fiscal impact is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Judiciary Committee to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. A more complete fiscal analysis will be prepared as the bill is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
