Measure Description:

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to, on annual basis, work with Oregon Health and Science University, each public university and each community college to determine number and graduation rates of former foster children and current foster children at each college or university.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Higher Education Coordinating Commission, Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Human Services to the Senate Committee on Education. The bill Requires Higher Education Coordination Commission (HECC) to work with Oregon Health and Science University, public universities, and community colleges, to determine the number and graduation rates of former foster children and current foster children at each college or university. HECC is required to make this information available to the public and to use the information when conducting annual evaluations of public universities. There may be a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Committee on Education.

Further Analysis Required
