**Measure Description:**

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish foster youth success centers in each public university.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Bonding, Higher Education Coordinating Commission

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Human Services to the Senate Committee on Education. The bill requires the Higher Education Coordination Commission (HECC) to establish a foster youth success center in each public university and authorizes the issuance of lottery bonds to finance the cost of developing these centers. There is a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Committee on Education.
