Measure Description:

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for construction and capital equipment of innovation and workforce training center in Rockwood neighborhood of Gresham.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Bonding, Department of Administrative Services (DAS)

Summary of Expenditure Impact:

The bill appropriates \$2 million General Fund to the Department of Administrative Services.

Analysis:

The bill appropriates \$2 million General Fund to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) and specifies that the money is to be used for the construction and capital equipment costs of an innovation and workforce training center to be located in the Rockwood neighborhood in Gresham. The costs to DAS associated with the accounting and transfer of the funds is minimal and can be absorbed within existing agency resources.
