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**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Adds the integration of oral health in the development of the community health improvement plans adopted by the coordinated care organizations and the community advisory councils.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Components of the measure
- Currently oral health integration not required
- The need to add oral health as a requirement to the Community Health Improvement Plans

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

When House Bill 3650 (2011) and Senate Bill 1580 (2012) were enacted and coordinated care organizations (CCOs) were established, the addition of oral health to their responsibilities was delayed for two years. As a result, the original transformation proposals submitted for approval for the establishment of the CCOs did not include plans on oral health integration. Subsequent plans and reports required to be provided by CCOS to the Oregon Health Authority also have not addressed the need for plans and strategies to integrate oral health.

House Bill 2675 requires the CCOs community health improvement plans and the community advisory councils to focus on and develop integration strategies that include oral health.
