Measure Description:

Directs the Department of Education to administer gifts, grants, and donation moneys to organizations that support career and technical student development opportunities.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Summary of Expenditure Impact:

Analysis:

The bill directs the Department of Education (ODE) to distribute money to career and technical organizations that provide opportunities for the development of student leadership, academic, and career skills. Organizations receiving this money are directed to manage their organization in coordination with ODE. Funding for moneys distributed to these organizations is sourced from Ballot Measure 98 (2016) revenues and ODE may also solicit or accept gifts, grants, donations, or any other source of public or private funds.

At this time, the Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) believes that the ramifications of this bill are not fully understood since the funding for Ballot Measure 98 is yet undetermined. Furthermore, ODE administration costs cannot be determined since they will vary depending on the quantity of organizations and amount of money distributed; and these details are not specified in the bill. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
