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## WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Changes the threshold of real property value on which a port is required to obtain a second appraisal before purchasing from \$500,000 to \$2 million.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Locations of Oregon's 23 ports
- Lack of secondary appraisers in more rural areas
- 1993 as the last year statutes related to port appraisals last amended

## **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Currently, a port is required to get a second appraisal on all real property purchases greater than \$500,000. It is difficult for some of Oregon's more rural ports to find a second appraiser that can accurately appraise port or marine property.

House Bill 2901 raises the threshold on real property requiring a second appraisal to \$2 million.
