BACKGROUND:

The Department of Administrative Services (DAS) currently has the authority to require fingerprints from its applicants and employees for the purpose of running nationwide criminal records checks. Senate Bill 86 extends that authority to include applicants or employees of the executive branch that have contracts or interagency agreements with DAS for human resource services.
