WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Adds 11 new designees to list of state agencies, entities and officials required to coordinate emergency preparedness and response with Office of Emergency Management.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Provisions of measure

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

Adds Oregon Travel Information Council to list.

BACKGROUND:

Oregon law currently requires 22 entities to designate an individual with the authority to allocate resources, to act as liaison with the Office of Emergency Management regarding emergency preparedness and response. Senate Bill 61-A adds 11 more designees from the following entities: the Department of Education, the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training, the Department of State Lands, the Department of Veterans' Affairs, the Employment Department, Oregon Housing and Community Services, Oregon Business Development Department, the Military Department, the Tourism Commission, the Secretary of State's office and the Oregon Travel Information Council.
