## **Measure Description:**

Requires Environmental Quality Commission to establish program to provide rebates to persons that purchase and register certain low emission vehicles and zero-emission transit buses in this state.

## **Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Energy, Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Department of Revenue(DOR)

### **Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Energy and Environment to the House Committee on Revenue. The bill requires the Environmental Quality Commission to create a program for the purpose of increasing the use of electric and battery-operating vehicles; as well as extends the sunset on tax credits for certified alternative fuel vehicle contributions. The Legislative Fiscal Office anticipates a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
