**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Revises statutes to maintain accuracy. Corrects punctuation and grammatical errors. Conforms language to legislative form and style. Removes obsolete references, standardizes terminology, and removes statutes from inappropriate series. Updates references to merged state agencies. Corrects citation to federal law. Clarifies impact of organizational meetings on member appointment to committees. Makes other non-substantive corrections. Resolves conflict with Senate Bill 302 (2017).

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Provisions of measure
- Early passage of measure assists in enrollment process of later measures
- Conflict with Senate Bill 302 resolved by amendment

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

Corrects conflict with Senate Bill 302 (2017).

**BACKGROUND:**

In every long session, the Office of Legislative Counsel introduces a “reviser’s bill” to make non-substantive, corrective, and technical changes to Oregon law.

House Bill 2601-A is this session's reviser's bill.
